

"OWIE DOLL"

The Owie Doll is used by medical personnel to communicate medical or surgical procedures to young patients. It is used by children to describe their feelings, fears and pain by drawing on the doll.

Sewing Instructions

Use the width of your machine foot as the width for the seam. Leave a gap of approximately 2.5 inches in one leg for stuffing. Snip into corners where indicated. Turn the doll inside out and stuff. Hand-sew the stuffing gap in the leg.

Stuffing Instructions

Dolls are stuffed through the gap in the leg. Chopsticks are good tools to push in stuffing. Start with the head, then arms, then legs and lastly the chest. The dolls should be firm, but not too firm. If legs or arms flop, more stuffing is needed.

sewing line - width of machine foot

"Owie Dolls" should be made out of 100% cotton material.

Flesh or pastel colors should be used so that they may be drawn on.

Stuffing should be of new cotton or poly-fill.

Do not use scraps for stuffing.
