Wanted: Women Who Want to Sew Great Garments...But are Afraid of Making a Mistake!

Peggy will share everything you need to know to accomplish a successful sewing project. In fact, she will make a button front, collared blouse during the lecture. Blouse details that apply to other garments will be discussed. Learn about interfacing, edge-stitching, cuff and collar attachment, setting in sleeves, and more. The goal is to give you the confidence to make a new garment for yourself.

Peggy will diagnose the fit of garments that the ladies are wearing... such as are the shoulders too narrow/wide, sleeve too tight/loose, pants too tight/baggy etc, etc. She will then diagram on a flip chart what you would do to fix the problem and give you the page to take home. If you want Peggy to diagnose your garment fit, wear the garment (any pattern or ready-to-wear) and sign-in at the door to get a number. You could also bring the garment and change when it is your turn.

Bring a brown bag lunch or get a quick bite to eat at a nearby restaurant.

Peggy will have her patterns and other items for sale.
